3. What is solar cooking? Mention the principle of solar cooking. Explain the pros and cons of using microwave for cooking. What is braising? 2+2+(2+2)+2
4. Distinguish between soluble and insoluble fibre. Elaborate the nutritional significance of dietary fibre. Write a short note on effects of too high and too low intake of dietary fibre. 2+4+4
5. What do you mean by antirachitic vitamin? Compare the clinical features that are common in deficiency of this vitamin in children and adult. Mention the factors affecting the absorption of calcium in our body. 2+4+4
6. Discuss in brief about the inter-relationship of calcium, vitamin-D and parathormone. State two rich sources of zinc. Write a short note on the toxic effects of excess vitamin-A consumption. 4+2+4
7. What is physiological fuel value? How is it different from gross fuel values? How is direct colorimetry differ from indirect colorimetry? Describe the relationship between food, nutrition, health and disease. 2+2+2+4

8. Describe the process of digestion and absorption of fat in GI tract. Mention the names of two saccharolytic enzyme. Write a short note on absorption of protein. (3+3)+2+2
9. What are the differences between boiling and steaming? What is balanced diet? What do you understand by Reference Woman? Define energy balance. What do you mean by SDA? 2+2+2+2+2
